FORM OF PAYMENT: Full payment of the registration fees indicated must accompany this form and must be received at the NACAC office by close of business (4:30 p.m. EDT) on July 6, 2009. Fees are payable to National Association for College Admission Counseling by check or credit card. Credit card payments will appear as NACAC on your billing statement. NACAC will accept registrations by fax only for participants wishing to pay by credit card. **All applicable fees and costs for GWI must be paid in full at the time of registration.**

Cancellation and substitution requests must be submitted in writing. GWI refunds are subject to a \$50 processing fee. To receive a full refund (less processing fee), cancellations must be received on or before June 6. A 50 percent refund (less processing fee) will be processed if request is received between June 7 and June 28. No refunds will be processed for requests received on or after June 29 or for no shows.

HOUSING: GWI participants stay at the Hyatt at Fisherman's Wharf. Reservations and housing costs are the responsibility of each participant. NACAC recommends that registrants wait for receipt of the email confirmation before making travel arrangements. Reservations must be received by July 7, 2008 to guarantee the NACAC rate.
